Who am I?





I was born on October 6th, 1846, and I was a contemporary of Thomas Edison and Nikola Tesla. I served in the Union Army in 1863 and the Union Navy from 1863 to 1865.

My father was a businessman, and from him, I was encouraged to become one myself. I was also an inventor. I designed and patented the railroad airbrake system in 1868 at the age of 23. In total, I received 360 patents from the United States, numerous more overseas, created 60 companies, received 10 awards/honors in my life and 12 more after my death. I passed away on March 12th, 1914.
